WebQuests, by definition, require analysis, synthesis, judgment, creativity, or problem-solving, ideally in the form of a task that is authentic, a smaller version of something adults do. These are powerful ways to engage students and utilize Web 2.0 tools!!

- Develop a webquest on-line for immediate use in the classroom
